## Rejoice!

Rejoice with us in how God provided for thirsty people this past year through the ministry of Life Giving Water Int'l and Kawsaypak Yaku. **You** are a significant part in giving "a cup of cold water in Jesus' name" through your prayer and financial support. Here is a glimpse of the people who now enjoy life-giving water:

- Children and their families heard the good news of Jesus' love for them in Vacation Bible school events and health & hygiene teaching devotionals.
- *Producción Agrícola* completed their water system providing clean well water to 78 families.
- Eighty families in *Tambillo* and *Milacruz* protected their springs and built a 14 kilometer feedline to their communities. They plan to complete the distribution early next year.

- *Chacapamba Quishuar's* 45 families protected their spring and rebuilt pumping facilities.
- Four *Azama* communities began their clean water system by protecting the springs for 310 families.
- *Maca Grande's* 23 families protected two springs providing 30 gallons per minute of crystal-clear water.
- The 50 families in *Tanquis* anticipate completing their water system in January.
- The Ecuador team continues designing water systems for several additional communities anxious to improve their health.
- Five interns came to Ecuador to work and learn about Christ-centered community development.
